Description	Focuses on how to connect a service member, veteran or family member into the resource system, using the Resource Connection Guide & Resource Match Tool.	Suicide prevention training focuses on the skills needed to assist a person who is experiencing a crisis or having suicidal thoughts. The following are options for suicide prevention training for you and your organization:

ASIST

(Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training) - ASIST is a 2-day interactive workshop in suicide first aid. ASIST teaches participants to recognize when someone may have thoughts of suicide and work with them to create a plan that will support their immediate safety.

Logistics: Open to anyone over the age of 16. No previous experience required. There may be a cost for this training. Be Connected scholarships may be available.

SafeTALK

safeTALK is a half-day in-person alertness training that prepares participants to become a suicide-alert helper.

Logistics: Open to anyone over the age of 15. No previous experience required. There may be a cost for this training.

MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID

The 8-hour in-person training gives participants the skills needed to reach out and provide initial help and support to someone who may be developing a mental health or substance use problem or experiencing a crisis. There is also a military/veteran specific version of this training.

Logistics: Open to anyone over the age of 18. No previous experience required. There may be a cost for this training.

CALM

CALM (Counseling Against Lethal Means) is a 2-hour online course focused on how to reduce access to lethal means as a suicide prevention strategy.

Logistics: Targeted to behavioral health providers but open to any adult who registers on the Suicide Prevention Resource Center website. No cost to participate.
