The Program Specialist will support implementation of key initiatives focused on reducing the disparity in suicides for Arizona veterans. This includes team and event support, participant tracking, data reporting and other tasks to support projects, events and initiatives.

EMPLOYMENT TYPE: Full-time

LOCATION: Team member must be located in Arizona. The position is hybrid (primarily working from home with regular statewide travel for training, outreach and events).

- A team-oriented approach to your work with a focus on problem-solving and finding solutions.
- Comfort with technology, including Microsoft Office, Google Suite, cloud-based platforms, CRMs, etc.



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A TYPICAL DAY:

- Report daily to the Be Connected Coordinator/Trainer.
- Provide support to team members for implementation of initiatives.
- Provide event support virtually and statewide including planning, set up, execution and follow up.
- Track program participants and ensure follow up actions take place as needed.
- Interface with community partners and community members, providing customer service and assistance.
- Assist with data reporting.
- Monitor and approve membership to the interactive community platform
- Other special projects and initiatives as needed.

IMPORTANT INFO

- This is a full-time, hybrid position based in Arizona.
- Cell phone and internet stipend provided.
- Vision, dental, disability and life insurance benefits are available, and a generous stipend is provided in lieu of health coverage.
- 403(b) plan with 6% employer contribution (regardless of employee contribution).
- Vacation, sick/mental health time, and paid time to vote and serve on jury duty are offered to all employees.
